Discussion Questions (pick 1-2 to spend more time with):

1. What was a time when you had to do something you thought was impossible? What happened?
2. What does the description ‘like sheep without a shepherd’ convey about the people? What do good shepherds provide for their sheep? How has Jesus been a Good Shepherd in your life?
3. Why do you think Jesus provided more food than was needed, even to the point that the disciples gathered leftovers? What lesson is Jesus teaching his disciples (now and then)?
4. What does Jesus do after He sends both the disciples and the crowd away (6:46)? What does that tell you about Jesus?
5. What did Jesus "see" in v.48 - How does this knowledge encourage you?
6. The disciples amazement was tied to their missing the lesson of the miraculous feeding of the multitude. What did they not understand? What did the feeding point to?
